Proposal Information

All proposals should be focused on one of the conference themes.

Types of Proposals

PAPER: Paper sessions provide an opportunity to present research and/or practice focused on one of the conference themes.

POSTER SESSION: Posters offer the opportunity to present a topic in display form rather than as a formal oral presentation.

ROUNDTABLE: Roundtable sessions offer opportunities to obtain insights and suggestions from colleagues in an informal, interactive format.

Only Electronic Submissions will be accepted for the Fall 2008 Conference.

For each proposal submitted electronically in Microsoft Word, authors must submit the following documents:

- A summary sheet containing (1) the name of a school/college affiliation, preferred address, preferred telephone number and e-mail address of each author; (2) format appropriate for the presentation (paper session, roundtable, or poster session); (3) conference theme on which the proposal is focused; and (4) a 50-word summary of the presentation suitable for inclusion in the Conference program.
- An anonymous, clearly titled abstract of no more than 250 words for blind review.

The **DEADLINE** for submitting proposals is **September 5, 2008.**

Authors with proposals accepted for presentation will be notified by **September 22, 2008.**

All presenters must be paid registrants of the fall conference.
